- 7. The APA Style of Reference (8 th Edition) must be strictly followed to while submitting the abstract and the final submission.

The nearest rail station is Malda Town (IRCTC code: MLDT) and highway NH -34 connects it to the northern and the southern parts of Bengal. By road Malda is 326 kilometer rs away from Kolkata and 253 kilometers away from Siliguri. The University is situated on NH -34 near Rabindra Bhawan. The Central Bus Terminus of Malda is adjacent to the University Campus.
