

Implementation of West Bengal Student Credit Card Scheme (WBSCCS):

- a. The Student Credit Card Scheme aims at providing financial support/ assistance by the State Government at a nominal interest rate to students residing in West Bengal for at least 10 years and pursuing education from class 10 onwards or studying in various coaching institutes for appearing in different competitive examinations, pursuing Undergraduate, Postgraduate courses including professional degree, Diploma courses and research at doctoral/ post-doctoral level or other similar courses in schools, colleges, Universities and other institutes within or outside the country, who are unable to pursue higher education due to financial constraints. The main emphasis is that students are provided with an opportunity to pursue higher education, with the financial support from the banking system with reasonable and affordable terms and conditions. Under this Scheme the aspiring students may upon fulfilling the terms and conditions detailed herein, obtain maximum loan of Rs. 10.00 lakhs at the rate of 4% simple interest from State Cooperative Banks and Public Sector/ Private Sector Banks operating in the State of West Bengal.
- **b.** In this connection, the Development officer was entrusted as the Nodal Officer as per the direction of the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor. The Office of the Development officer conducted numerous Online Meetings and Training with the PG Departments of UGB, 26 Affiliated Colleges under UGB and others.
- c. Various Awareness Camps were organized at the University Campus.





Around 280 PG Students have applied for the Scheme, and the office has endlessly provided support to students interested in it.
