গৌড়বঙ্গ বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়ের নতুন উপাচার্য পবিত্র

স্টাফ রিপোর্টার, মালদহ: গৌড়বঙ্গ বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়ের উপাচার্য নিয়োগ নিয়ে রাজ্যের সঙ্গে রাজভবনের চানাপোড়েনের অবসান ঘটল বৃহস্পতিবার। এই ইস্যুতে রাজ্যের উচ্চশিক্ষা দপ্তরের প্রস্তাবে আগেই সিলমোহর দিয়েছিলেন আচার্য তথা রাজ্যপাল সিদ্ধি আনন্দ বোস। রাজভবন থেকে নিয়োগপত্র পেয়ে এদিন গৌড়বঙ্গের উপাচার্য হিসাবে দায়িত্বভার নিলেন ড. পবিত্র চট্টোপাধ্যায়। তিনি বর্ধমান বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়ের রসায়ন বিভাগের প্রধান ছিলেন। তাঁকে দায়িত্বভার তুলে দেন বিদ্যায়ী উপাচার্য রজত কিশোর দে। দায়িত্ব নিয়েই পড়াশোনার উন্নয়নের বিষয়ে জোর দেওয়ার পক্ষে সওয়াল করেন তিনি। বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়ের হস্টেল সমস্যার দ্রুত সমাধানের পাশাপাশি নতুন একটি অডিটোরিয়াম তৈরির উদ্যোগ নেবেন বলে জানিয়েছেন। এদিন নতুন উপাচার্যকে স্বাগত জানাতে অধ্যাপক ও কর্মীরা একটি অনুষ্ঠানের আয়োজন করেন। সেখানে বক্তব্য রাখেন নয়া উপাচার্য প্রফেসর পবিত্র চট্টোপাধ্যায়। পড়াশোনার বিষয়ে সার্বিক উন্নয়নের জন্য বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়ের সমস্ত

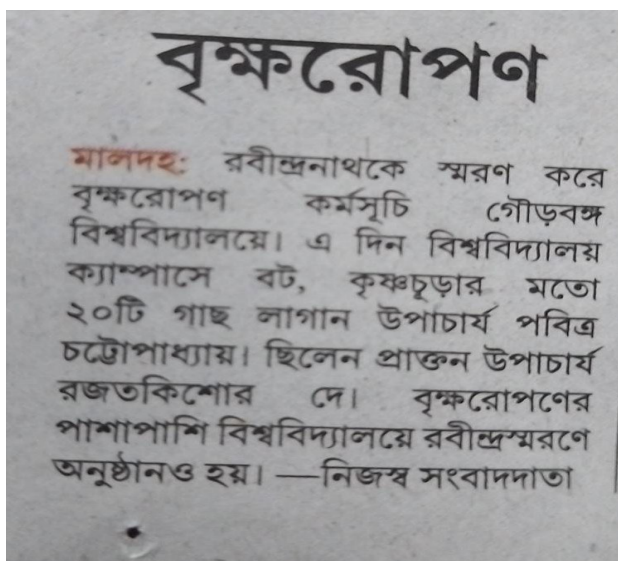
Workshop on Mental Health, Mental illness and Stress Management:

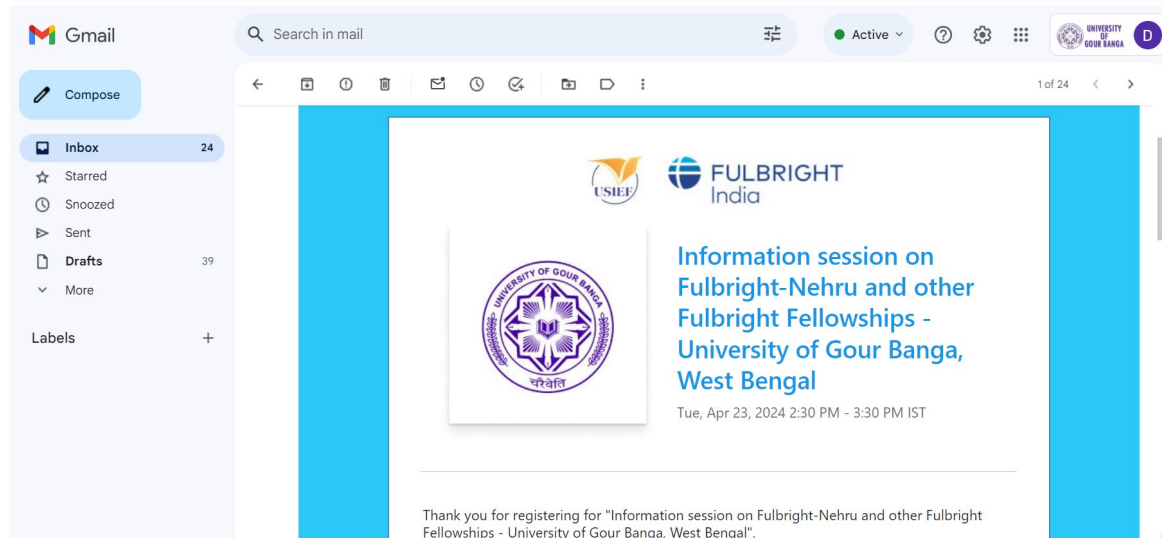


University celebrates International Yoga Day:

Celebration of World Environment Day 2024:

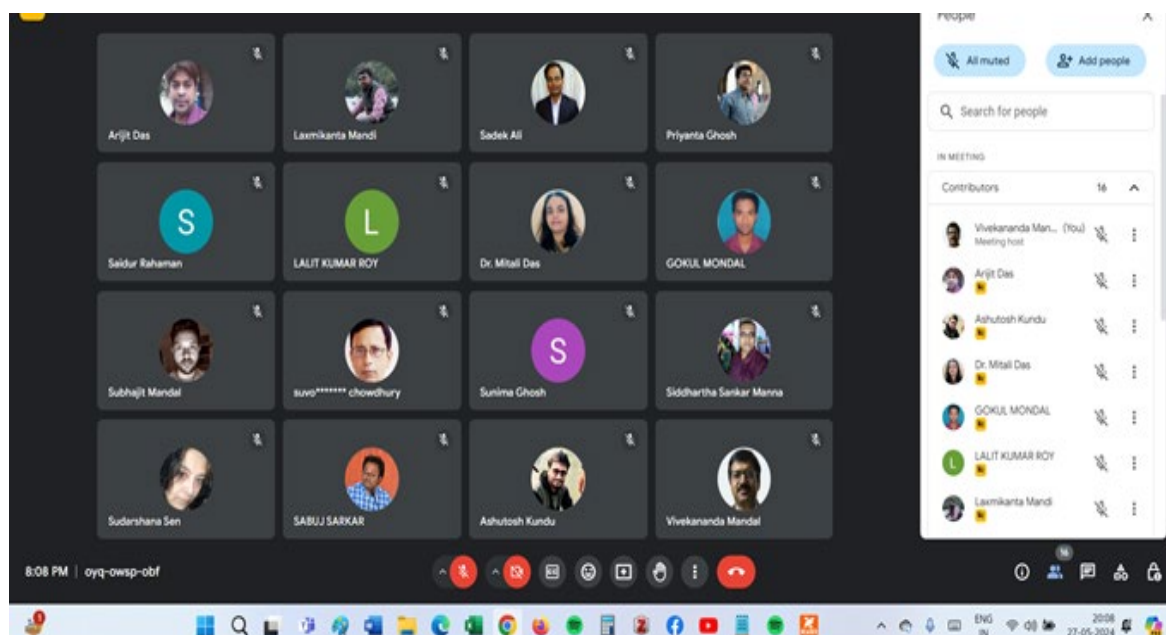

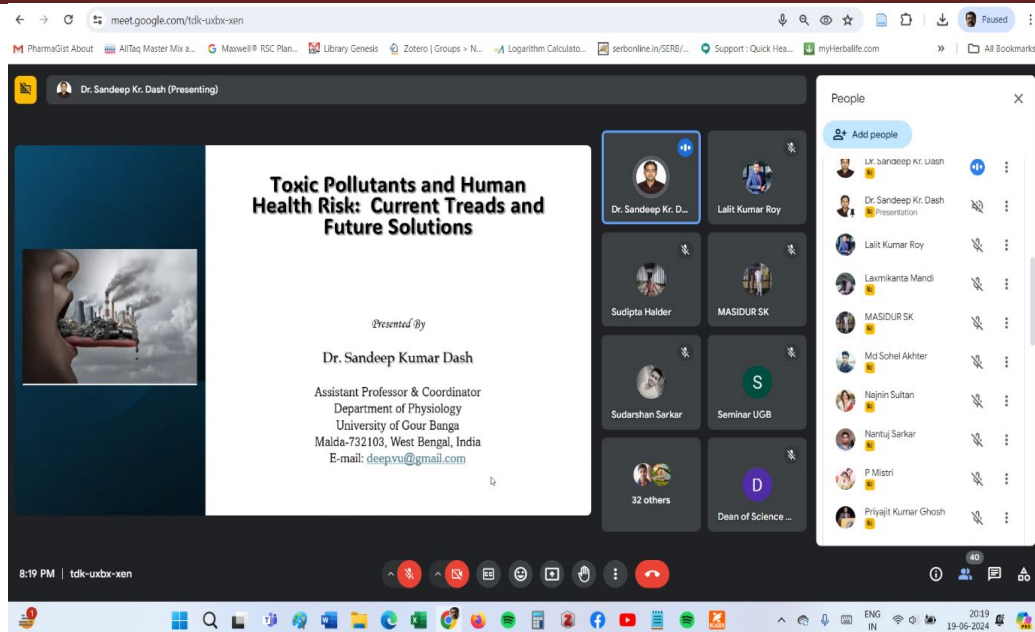


Screenshot of the World Environment Day – 2024 celebration online presentations by **Dr Sunil Saha**, Assistant Professor, Department of Geography, UGB

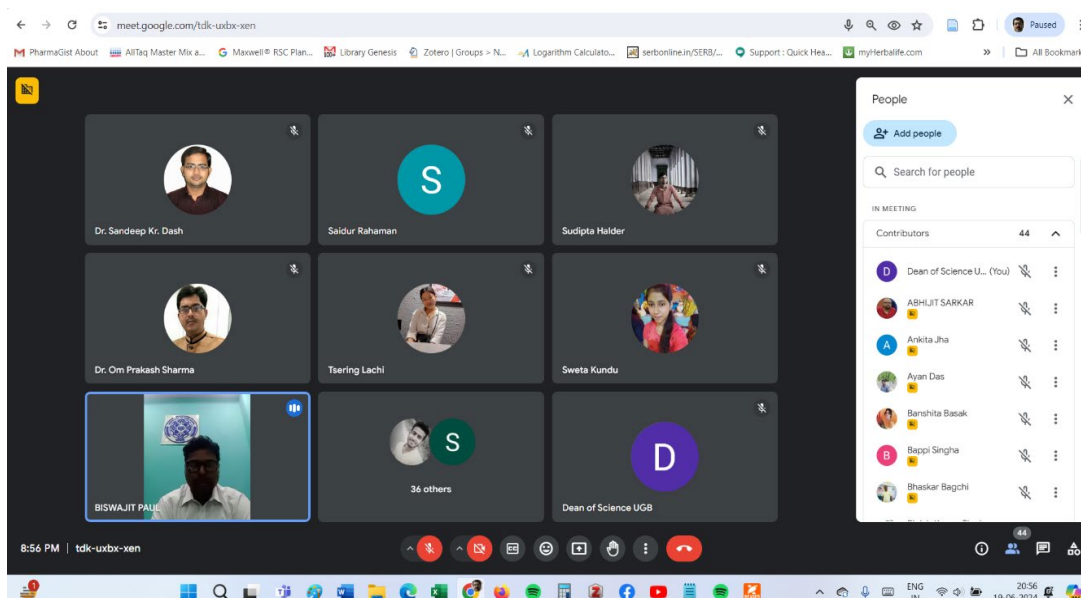
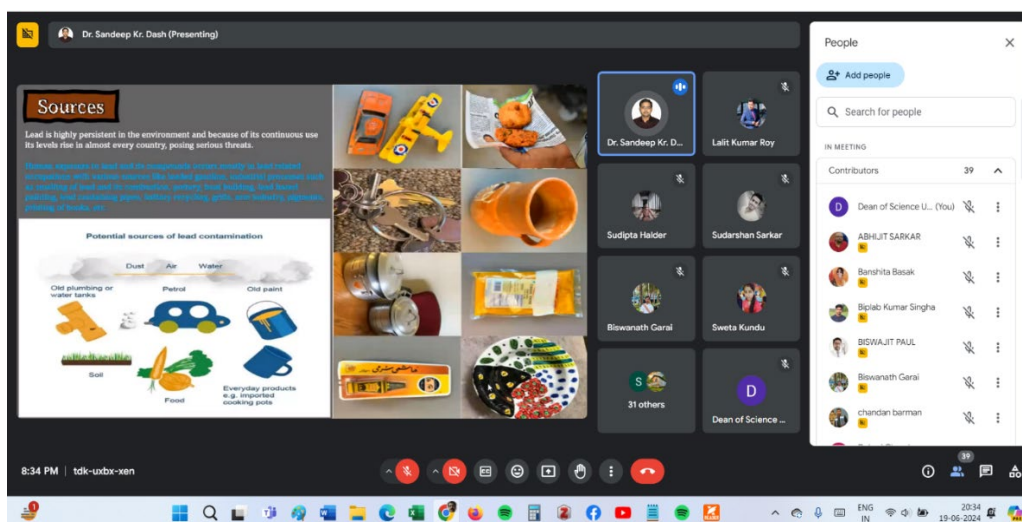

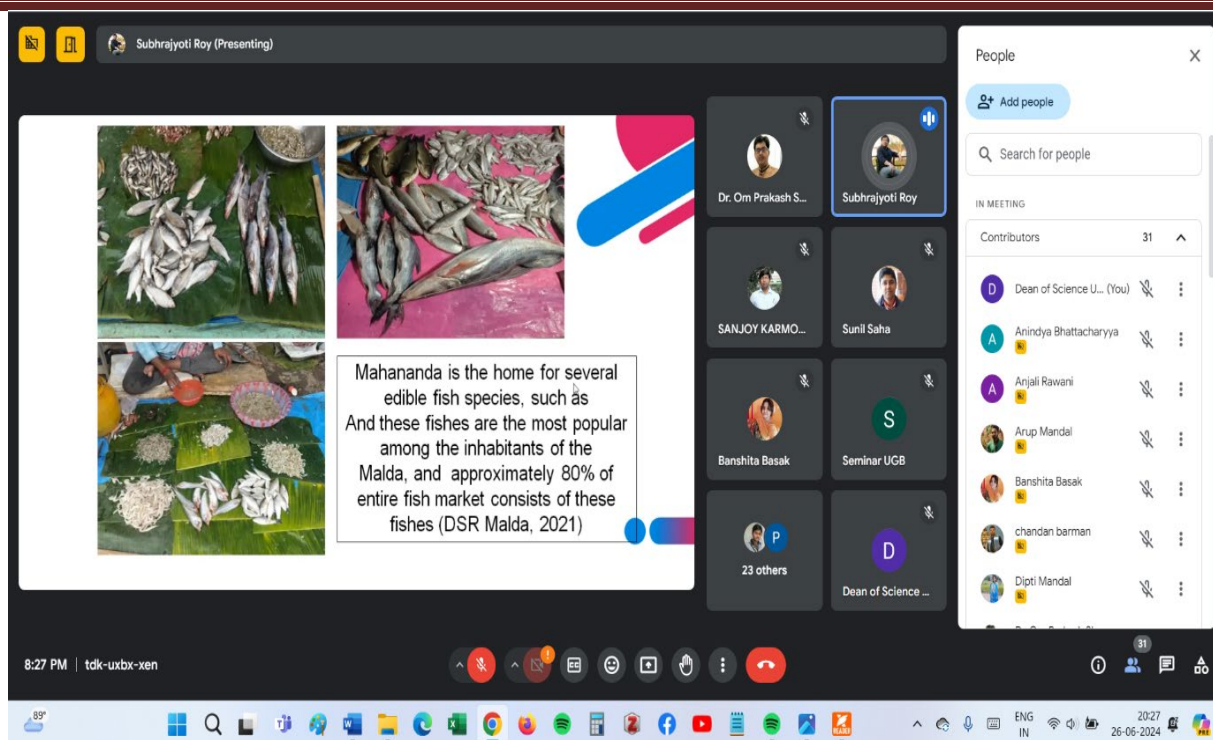

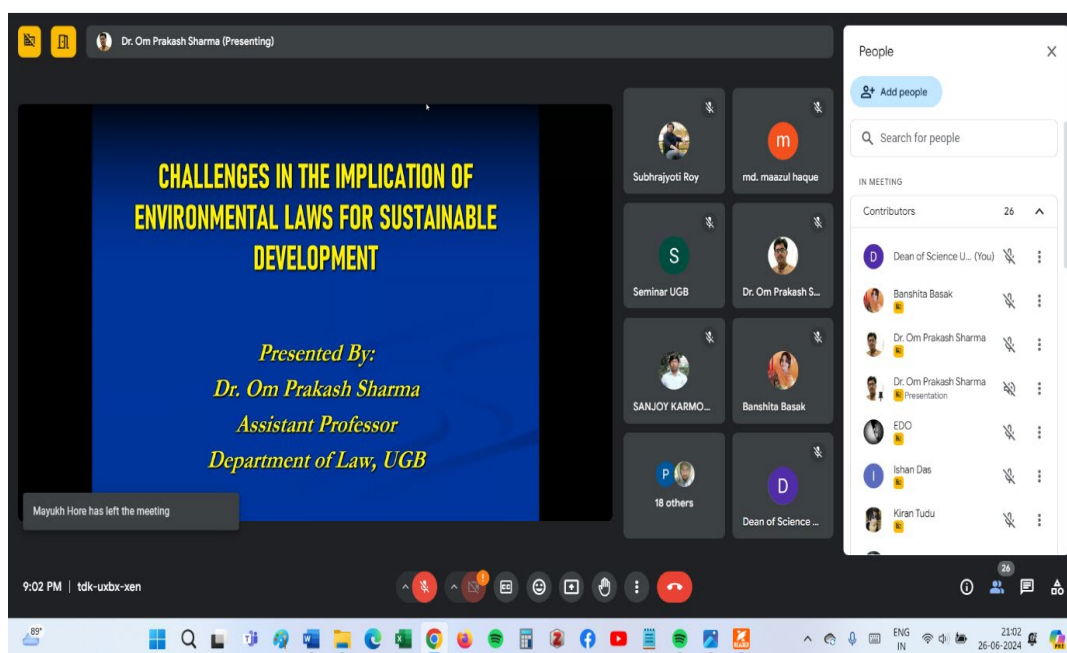
